Dear Minister,

I am writing on behalf of my friends at People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) India to request that you take immediate steps to seize an elephant, known simply as "Number 44", who is being forced to give rides in Jaipur. As you undoubtedly know, tourists recently witnessed this elephant being violently beaten, in violation of the law.

It has been three years since an inspection team authorised by the Animal Welfare Board of India documented rampant and widespread abuse of elephants used for rides in Jaipur, including at Amber Fort. As this recent beating indicates, conditions there remain extremely grim. Elephants are suffering and need help now.

I respectfully request that you start with Number 44, who should be confiscated and sent to a rehabilitation facility for treatment and care. This animal deserves to live without chains and in the company of other elephants.
