CONTACT US if you have seen any of these possible violations:

- Using animals for dissection or other classroom teaching purposes
- Making animals sick or injuring them in experiments
- Not providing animals with adequate veterinary care
- Hitting, screaming at, or otherwise abusing animals
- Causing animals so much distress that they begin to self-mutilate
- Forcing animals to live in small, filthy, or dangerous cages (e.g. with broken wires, etc)
- Not providing animals with sufficient pain relief during or after painful procedures
- Not providing animals with sufficient food or water
- Killing animals in painful ways (e.g. cutting their heads off, placing them in the freezer, etc)
- Using animals in experiments when nonanimal alternatives were available
- Transporting animals to a laboratory in an inhumane manner via truck, plane, or ship

If you have seen any of these or any other inhumane conditions or practices that you think may violate any guidelines, laws, or regulations, please contact us – we will do everything we can to stop the abuse.
